DIMENSIONS	REQUIREMENT / PRACTICE
Comfort & Safety	Clean, safe, decent quality within the client's budget
Labor & Human Rights	Fair wages, safe work, and child-protection compliance
Plastic & Waste	No single-use plastics; organic and recyclables separated; composting
Energy & Water	Energy-efficient appliances, LED lighting, low-flow fixtures, and guest prompts
Biodiversity & Sourcing	Use local, Fair-Trade-sourced goods; no endangered species on property or menu
Cultural & Community	Local design integration, community benefits, respect of IP rights
Engagement	Contracts with sustainability clauses, self-assessments, and certification preference
Incentives / Sanctions	Positive promotion for sustainable suppliers; warnings leading to termination if needed
Client Engagement	Feedback surveys, traveller behaviour guidance, and sustainability disclosures
Governance	Sustainability Manager; biennial review; regular monitoring and reporting
Capacity Building	Training, tools, supplier workshops, and collaborative initiatives
